Stuchlý Jan	1960-1962	lichenological collections of this bryologist
Suza Jindřich	1920-1951	the complete <i>Cladonia</i> collections
Svoboda David	1999-	recent collection from Český kras, Albania etc.
Syrovátková Lada	2007-2013	specimens from diploma thesis (Doupovské hory Mts) and many field excursions
Váňa Jiří	1960-1990	lichenological collections of this bryologist
